# PURPLE CAT



## MATERIALS

CCX525 Sitting Kitty  
Detail Brush  
Small Brush  
Medium Brush  
Sponge  
Marker

## COLORS

CMM 101 - Fresh Heather  
CMM 31 - Licorice  
CMM 67 - Snowflake  
CMM 82 - Olive You  
CMM 10 - Grape Soda  
CMM 83 - Passionate Plum

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Use marker to lightly sketch out lines on the cat for where you will use different colors. We did a circle around the face, an oval on the chest, the tip of the tail, and the legs.
2. Fill in the following areas with 3 coats of Fresh Heather: inside the ears, the nose, the chest, and the tip of the tail.
3. Paint the remainder of the body of the cat with 3 coats of Grape Soda, except for the bottom half of the legs, and inside the circle on the face.
4. Use a detail brush to fill in the eyes with 3 coats of Olive You.
5. Paint inside the circle on the face with 3 coats of Passionate Plum. To help the color fade into the lighter purple, paint more Grape Soda around the face and then lightly tap on some Passionate Plum where the colors meet with a sponge to blend.
6. Paint the bottom of the front legs with 3 coats of Passionate Plum. To help the color fade into the lighter purple on top of the leg, paint more Grape Soda to the top of the leg and then lightly tap on Passionate Plum where the colors meet with a sponge to blend.
7. Paint the outside of the ears with one more coat of Grape Soda, then tap Passionate Plum on the top with the sponge and allow the colors to blend.
8. Use a detail brush to outline the eyes and add the pupil.
9. Finally, dip the handle of the detail brush into Snowflake and tap a highlight on each eye.

## TIPS

- When using a detail brush, the harder you press on the brush the heavier the lines will be.
- 3 coats of paint will give you a solid color.
- The colors will blend best with a sponge when both colors are wet.
- After you dip the sponge into the paint, tap off the excess on a paper towel.
